1. Introduction:

With the enlightenment of Holy Spirit, my consultation and guidance of His Eminence Cardinal Charles Bo (Archbishop of Yangon Archdiocese) and of His Excellency Bishop John Saw Yaw Han (Auxiliary Bishop of Yangon Archdiocese), Joseph Education Institute (JEI) was founded on 12th January 2015 as the first institute ever run by a layman in the history of Myanmar Catholic Church for Lay Theological formation.

Since 2016, with generous financial support of MISSIO Aachen and of **Porticus Asia**, we have opened the Correspondent Diploma Degree Course on Catholic Theological Studies. Upon this course, we surprisingly received unbelievable response from our fellow Catholics, denominations and other religions too.





2. Student Enrollment:

In our 2018-2019 academic year (Batch-3), there were (72) enrolled students but only (64) students (Male 37, Female 27) passed our diploma degree program which takes 18 months.

Therefore all (64) students were graciously awarded our Diploma Degree on Distant Catholic Theological Studies on 30th November 2019 at Melia Hotel in Yangon, Myanmar.

To this graduation ceremony, (60) students attended it and took the diploma degree from us. The rest diploma certificates of graduated students will be sent to our students by postal service which is now excellent in service with in safety too.




5. Evaluation on Students' Learning and on Teaching Courses




a. Overview of Students' Impression on our (8) Subjects


There are 64 students who participated in our structural interview and post-survey. Regarding overview of our graduated students on our offering courses for their diploma degree program, 29.7 % of our students reported us "Excellent" and 70.3% said "good".




























K. Subjects


Whereas we asked them if (8) subjects are too much for their study for their diploma degree, (85.9%) of our students said subjects are reasonable but (4.7%) of them said "too much" and (6.3%) of them "little".



L. Subject Understanding


Whereas we asked them if (8) subjects are too easy for their learning, for their diploma degree, (45.3%) students said they widely understand subjects, (37.5%) students said they fairly understand them, (17.2%) students said they poorly understand them well.






n. Subjects Learning




O. Consultation or Tuition




Whereas we asked them about JEI service, (57.8%) of our students said "excellent", but (42.2%) of them said "normal".




Whereas we asked them about their communication to JEI, (95.3%) of our students said easy and (4.7%) of them said "not easy".






T. Education Level
